**Worship Team Meeting** 3d Sabbath, each month, immediately after Fellowship Lunch (about 2 pm). Greg Peck leads.

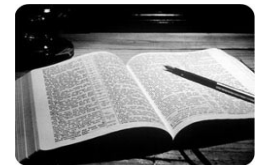
